



Dressing procedure CORONA



	In the hallway or in the lock	
1.	Disinfect hands	
2.	Put on FFP2 mask, take care that all edges join to the skin, press nose well On	

3.	Put on splash goggles	
4.	Put on green apron and press thumb through extra fixation of sleeves	
5.	Put on the glove the sleeve of the apron	




NB: When visiting, only change gloves after patient contact, rest isolation clothes may stay on provided that no visible dirt is present on items.





Multi-room undressing procedure

In the patient room		
1.	<p>Pull on apron and gloves off at the same time in a move and throw in blue box with yellow lid</p>	
2.	<p>Disinfect the hands and go outside</p>	
In the hallway		
3.	<p>Take off splash goggles, Deposit these in the appropriate container</p>

Isolation room isolation procedure

In the patient room		
1.	Remove gloves and disinfect the hands and enter the lock	
2.	Deposit glove relevant WIVA vessel	
3.	Disinfect the hands	
In the lock		
4.	Remove the apron and deposit in blue container	

		
5.	Remove the splash goggles	
6.	Remove the FFP2 mask and leave this in lock to reusable. Put your name on it	
7.	Disinfect the hands	

NB: materials should be cleaned after use with 70% alcohol by 10% isopropyl alcohol
